Liverpool to Blackpool North: on Sunday 04 July, the 2231 train will finish at Preston. A bus will run from Preston to Blackpool. From Monday 05 through to Thursday 08 July, the 2214 train from Blackpool will finish at St Helens Central. Buses will run from St Helens to Liverpool.

Manchester Victoria to Liverpool: from Monday 05 through to Thursday 08 July, the 2239 and 2309 trains from Manchester will not be able to call at stations between Earlestown and Liverpool. Buses will run between Earlestown and Liverpool.
