991 992	Kirkby circulars	From 01 September, on schooldays: the 1458 Route 991 bus was rerouted to run via Wellfield Avenue to Cherryfield Drive so no longer serves Leeside Avenue or Bewley Drive and the 1416 Route 992 bus was rerouted to run via James Holt Avenue to Kirkby Row, so no longer serves William Roberts Avenue or Sidney Powell Avenue.
