



Changes to bus services



during
March 2010

Welcome to your monthly guide to bus service changes in Merseyside.

We produce this leaflet at the end of each month so you can keep you in touch with planned changes to bus services during the following month.

This leaflet shows a summary of the planned changes that are taking place to bus services in Merseyside during March 2010.

It contains a summary of the changes we have been told about by the bus companies up to the time of going to print on 25 February.

1 Liverpool - Chester



Service changes on: 28 March 2010

The timetable is changed - buses between Liverpool and Chester now run every 15 minutes (this replaces the current combined 10 minute frequency between Liverpool - Chester and Birkenhead - Chester). The last Monday to Friday bus from Liverpool now runs 15 minutes earlier and is extended to finish at Ellesmere Port. The last Saturday evening bus from Liverpool now runs 15 minutes earlier and now finishes at Ellesmere Port, so no longer serves Chester. Buses to Liverpool now finish at Crosshall Street, and buses from Liverpool now start in Sir Thomas Street, so no longer serve the bus stop on Dale Street. All Monday to Saturday times are changed. The morning Cheshire County Council bus which ran between Marshlands and Hooton Crossroads is withdrawn.

12, 12A Birkenhead - Arrowe Park



Service changes on: 01 March 2010

Both services are rerouted to run via Park Road South, instead of Park Road North. The times are changed.

23 Heswall - Chester



Service changes on: 08 March 2010

Some morning and afternoon times are changed.

53 Liverpool - Crosby or Aintree



Service changes on: 14 March 2010

The 1700 Monday to Friday bus from Queen Square Bus Station now finishes at Crosby, so no longer runs to Aintree. On Saturdays, an extra bus is introduced from Queen Square Bus Station to Crosby, departing at 1740.

58C Bootle - Netherton circular



Service changes on: 25 March 2010

The 0810 bus from Bootle no longer runs on schooldays.

61 Liverpool - Prescot, Widnes or Runcorn



Service changes on: 29 March 2010

The short journey buses between Liverpool and Prescot are rerouted in Prescot to run in a one way loop from Hall Lane via Steley Way, Warrington Road, Prescot Bus Station, Sewell Street and Hall Lane back to Liverpool. When travelling from Liverpool to Prescot, these buses are renumbered 61A. Some morning times are changed.

Service changes on: 01 March 2010

The Saturday times are changed.

122 Crosby - Fazakerley**Service changes on: 01 March 2010**

Some Monday to Friday times are changed.

375,385 Southport - Wigan**Service changes on: 21 March 2010**

Monday to Saturday daytime buses from Wigan to Southport now run 2 minutes later. Buses travelling from Southport to Wigan are unchanged.

Line 1 Skelmersdale - St Helens - Warrington**Service changes on: 22 March 2010**

The route is changed in St Helens town centre - buses to Skelmersdale no longer serve Parr Street, Church Street or Hall Street and buses to Warrington no longer serve Standish Street or Atlas Street. The route is also changed in Carr Mill, with buses now running via Windermere Avenue, Loughrigg Avenue and Mosedale Avenue instead of Wasdale Avenue and Dunmail Avenue. The times are changed - the service now starts later and finishes earlier.

Line 3 Prescot - St Helens - Billinge**New service from: 22 March 2010**

New Line 3 is introduced, running between Prescot, Whiston, St Helens and Billinge, every 60 minutes during Monday to Saturday daytimes. Both Line 1 and Line 3 combine to provide a 30 minute frequency between Carr Mill and Billinge.
