Planned changes to bus services

Planned changes to rail services

City Line:

Monday 11 to Thursday 14 February

The 2315 Liverpool Lime Street to Preston service will be a reduced stop service and will not call at Prescot, Eccleston Park, Thatto Heath, Garswood and Bryn. A rail replacement bus will be provided from Huyton.

The 2235 Wilmslow to Liverpool Lime Street service will terminate at Manchester Piccadilly.

The 2331 Liverpool Lime Street to Manchester Victoria service will not run.

Rail replacement buses will be provided.

2100 Newcastle to Liverpool Lime Street terminates at Manchester Victoria with a replacement coach provided onward to Newton-le-Willows, Lea Green and Liverpool Lime Street.

Tuesday 12 to Friday 15 February

The 0528 Manchester Victoria to Liverpool Lime Street service will start from Manchester Piccadilly at 0525.

Northern has RMT strike action planned for Saturday 9 and 16 February. If this goes ahead then few Northern services will run after 5pm. For further info see northernrailway.co.uk/strike

Northern Line:

Phase 6 of the platform upgrade work will continue on the Southport line until 24 February 2019.

Sunday 10 February 2019

Trains will run between Hunts Cross and Hall Road. Passengers can board a rail replacement bus service at Hall Road station, which will call at all stations to and from Southport.

As part of the works Ainsdale level crossing will be closed during all or some of these dates. During the road closure: Rail replacement buses to Liverpool will run from the bus stop on Liverpool Road outside Toby Carvery. Rail replacement buses to Southport will run from the bus stop on the opposite side of Liverpool Road outside Winrow Interior Design.

Monday 11 February - Sunday 24 February

Rail replacement buses will run between Formby and Moorfields stations.

As well as regular rail replacement buses stopping at all affected stations, express buses will run between selected stations Mondays to Saturdays.

Trains will continue to run between Sandhills and Liverpool stations. If you are travelling on the Southport line and wish to change onto the Ormskirk or Kirkby lines please change onto a train at Sandhills station.

Between 11 and 17 February, Hall Road rail replacement bus services may be affected by the possible closure of Hall Road level crossing. Any changes will be confirmed nearer the time, if you use Hall Road station please visit the website nearer the time to double check your timetables.
