Planned changes to bus services

There are no planned changes to bus services this week.

Note: Football Special Services (917, 919 and Taxi One)

Due to congestion issues in the city centre the departure point for these services has been moved from St Johns Lane to Lime Street/St Georges Plateau for the remainder of the football season.



Planned changes to rail services

City Line:

Monday 15 to Thursday 18 April

The 2250 Manchester Airport to Liverpool Lime Street service will terminate at Manchester Piccadilly.

The 2329 Manchester Oxford Road to Liverpool Lime Street service will not run.

The 2338 Liverpool Lime Street to Manchester Piccadilly service will not run.

Rail replacement buses will be provided.

Saturday 20 April

The Manchester Airport trains to Manchester and Kirkby/Southport will run to a different timetable.

Liverpool to Wigan and Blackpool trains will also run to an alternative timetable.

Northern Line:

There are no planned engineering works on the Northern Line.

Wirral Line:

Phase 8 of the platform upgrade work continues between West Kirby and Birkenhead North.

Rail replacement buses will run between:

West Kirby and Birkenhead North from 7 April to 14 April

West Kirby and Bidston/Birkenhead North from 15 April to 22 April

Trains will run from Birkenhead North throughout the work

On Tuesday 23 April a normal train service will run.

Sunday 7 April - Monday 22 April

Rail replacement buses will run between West Kirby and Birkenhead North, calling at all stations.

Passengers can board trains at Birkenhead North to complete their onward journey.

Due to the work on the West Kirby line, there will be less trains than normal running from Sunday 7 April to Sunday 14 April, from stations between Birkenhead North and Liverpool city centre.

Planned Mersey Tunnels Closures

There are no planned full closures of the Mersey Tunnels.

The Kingsway (Wallasey) Mersey Tunnel:

Resurfacing work on the Kingsway Tunnel approach and exit roads in Wallasey started on Monday 18 March and is planned to run until Easter. Work is scheduled to be carried out between 9pm and 6am mid-week and on Sundays, when traffic is at its lightest, to minimise disruption for tunnel users. Diversions will be in place and drivers are asked to consider this when planning their journeys.

The information given is currently correct however, for a number of reasons, closures may be subject to change at short notice.
