Little Sutton Footbridge

Between the 18th - 28th June the footbridge at Little Sutton station will be closed for essential maintenance work. Access between platforms will be via the road bridge and customers should be aware of the potential added journey time.

## Planned Mersey Tunnels Closures

There are no planned full closures of the Mersey Tunnels this week.

The Kingsway (Wallasey) Mersey Tunnel:

Resurfacing work on the Kingsway Tunnel approach and exit roads in Wallasey started on Monday 18 March and is planned to run until mid-June.

Work is scheduled to be carried out between 9pm and 6am mid-week and on Sundays, when traffic is at its lightest, to minimise disruption for tunnel users.

Vehicles below 3.5 tonnes are able to use Queensway Tunnel as an alternative route.

Diversions will be in place and drivers are asked to consider this when planning their journeys.

The information given is currently correct however, for a number of reasons, closures may be subject to change at short notice.
