Northern Line:

In preparation for your brand new trains, the next phase of platform upgrade works will take place on the Kirkby line between **7 September** and **15 September 2019**.

Between Monday and Saturday rail replacement buses will run between Kirkby and Sandhills calling at all stations. On Sundays rail replacement buses will run between Kirkby and Moorfields stations.

From Monday 16 September a normal train service will run on this line calling at all stations.

Ticket offices at all Kirkby line stations will still be staffed.

Northern (Arriva) trains will run from Kirkby station as usual.

Wirral Line:

Due to platform upgrade works platform 2 (towards Rock Ferry) at Green Lane will be out of use. Trains from Liverpool to Chester and Ellesmere Port will not stop at Green Lane between **8 September** and **20 October 2019**.

Passengers travelling towards Hooton/Chester or Ellesmere Port from Green Lane should board any Liverpool bound train from Platform 1 and change at Birkenhead Central for their onward journey.

Passengers travelling from Liverpool to Green Lane are advised to travel to Rock Ferry and change onto a Liverpool bound train which will call at Green Lane.

Passengers should allow extra time for their journeys.

Please note: The last train from Liverpool will not call at Rock Ferry. Trains toward Liverpool are not affected by these works.
