There are no planned engineering works on the Northern Line.

Wirral Line:

Phase 10 of the platform upgrade work will continue at Overpool station until 15 June 2019.

During this time trains from Liverpool will not stop at Overpool.

Passengers travelling to Overpool from Liverpool are advised to travel to Ellesmere Port and remain on the train until it returns to Overpool.

Passengers travelling to Ellesmere Port from Overpool should board any train from Overpool towards Liverpool and change onto a Ellesmere Port bound train at Little Sutton. Please note that Little Sutton platforms can only be accessed via steps. Passengers requiring step free access should continue on to Hooton station where there are lifts to the platforms.

Planned Mersey Tunnels Closures

There are no planned full closures of the Mersey Tunnels this week.

The Kingsway (Wallasey) Mersey Tunnel:

Resurfacing work on the Kingsway Tunnel approach and exit roads in Wallasey started on Monday 18 March and is planned to run until mid-June.

Work is scheduled to be carried out between 9pm and 6am mid-week and on Sundays, when traffic is at its lightest, to minimise disruption for tunnel users.

Vehicles below 3.5 tonnes are able to use Queensway Tunnel as an alternative route.

Diversions will be in place and drivers are asked to consider this when planning their journeys.

The information given is currently correct however, for a number of reasons, closures may be subject to change at short notice.
